The Year in Review

This outreach happened at UW-Madison, UW-Whitewater, and UW-Platteville. Over 1300 students came out for this event and 48 indicated making a decision for Christ. Perhaps what is more amazing is that from that team three students are going back full-time for this upcoming year! This is why Vision Trips are so incredible. They not only reach students during the trip but the Lord uses the trip to raise up laborers for His harvest!


Students from UW-Madison, Platteville, and Whitewater at TCX. From this conference many decided to go for a summer or a year to do missions around the globe.

Big Break: One of the best events of the year! 72 students went to this conference from Madison where we hit the beach everyday to share our faith with the 100,000 spring breakers. There are amazing results as students share their faith both at Big Break and back on campus.

Passion Week Outreach: This year, school was in session during Holy Week which is unusual. It allowed us a unique opportunity to talk about Jesus and the message of the Gospel. We did a number of different events throughout the week including handing out over 3000 Easter eggs that had candy and a short gospel presentation inside, a spaghetti dinner for friends to bring friends to, handing out over 500 "More Than a Carpenter" books, a showing of "The Passion of the Christ," and a clear presentation on evidence for the resurrection called "The Rise of a Hero."
