This first guy was an atheist and polite but very uninterested. In the second conversation the guy had grown up without religion in his life but was interested in hearing about Jesus. And in the third conversation the girl was a solid Christian who was trying to live her life for the Lord despite having made some decisions that came with very difficult consequences.

This is a snapshot of what we are seeing on campus. There is a broad diversity of belief. The encouraging part is that those with faith in Jesus seem to be wanting to live it out. Those without faith, even though they have gone to church, no longer pretend to be either culturally Christian or culturally religious. Often, however, there are very good conversations with these students leading to sharing the Gospel!

This semester has been full of prayer walks and talking with students about Jesus. We’ve gotten to partner, to varying degrees, in these walks and talks with both the Navigators and Intervarsity which has been fun. We’ve been praying for openings with sports teams and the good news is that we have some traction with athletes for next semester. Thanks so much for praying with us!
