After a great conversation where the woman heard a simple message of salvation they walked away and Amanda said, "That was so great. I could do that all day!" She was so excited to be able to share Jesus with someone who didn't know Him! (DeAnn said her excitement was contagious!)

 Please pray as we share Jesus with others. Pray that God would lead us to people who are ready to hear. Pray for Amanda that God would bless her faithfulness.

This week is a special week called "Killing the Giants." (The "giant" being whatever fear holds us back from sharing the gospel.) The students have set faith goals and are trusting the Lord for 1493 spiritual conversations with people and for the ability to present the gospel 702 times this week.

 Pray that our students would be courageous and trust the Lord in all of this and that at the end of the week we'd be able to really celebrate together.
