



Clean water and the Gospel? You better Belize it!

A mission trip to Belize is right around the corner!

Next week four Destino students, seven church members, and myself are going to be ministering with an organization called "Filter of Hope." (<http://www.filterofhope.org/>) We're asking the Lord to use us to bring clean water to some of the poorest people in the country of Belize.

Our goal is for 70 families to have clean water at the end of next week who currently don't. This is really significant—especially for the youngest of those families. Children tend to be the most susceptible to waterborne illness.

But water alone, while good, answers only the felt need. Filter of Hope trains us to use the water filter to explain the message of the Gospel.
