It's been a great semester! When I look back at the start of the semester I don't think I was expecting the semester to be as fun or as fruitful as it has been. We started the semester really going after multiple campuses around the city in ways that we never had before. We were trusting God to raise up students who wanted to invest their lives in others to a greater degree than they had before. And because of that we had some students really back out of leadership. So at times the decision and new vision were difficult to follow.

But beginning with the Harvey Relief Trip (from the last letter) we started to see the new generation of student leaders really begin to lead. And a couple weeks ago I was thinking about the ministries all over the city right now and I realized that we have around 85 students involved in the movements—and that at each campus we have students actually leading and multiplying their lives in others.

DeAnn and I host a Bible study and dinner every week with local church members bringing meals to feed the students. It has really helped created a sense of togetherness and community that helps these students continue to walk with Jesus in college even when those around them are pulling them in other directions.
