Our Dear Friends,

We have been so encouraged about the ministry we're pursuing as we've spoken weekly to Chris, our campus director. He's been sharing that he is seeing things happening that he has not seen in his 15 years at Dartmouth. Every time we talk to him we get more excited to get to New Hampshire!

One of the most encouraging things he's shared has been about Bible studies and discussion groups that are happening among the new freshmen. Andrew and Charlie, two juniors, are leading a Bible study with 12-15 freshmen guys. Some of *those* guys are leading a discussion group in their dorm with freshmen who aren't Christians to talk about spiritual things and what it might mean to pursue a relationship with God. There are 20 freshmen attending this group every week! And Carolyn, one of our staff teammates, is leading a Bible study for freshmen women and is consistently seeing 12 women come to that, too! We've never seen anything like this level of interest among new students.

Chris has shared, too, that there are more freshmen who want to be involved in these groups, but not enough people to lead them. Dartmouth currently has no female staff who are full-time on campus; so while there are more women who want to be in a Bible study, there aren't staff to lead them or to train upperclassmen to lead them. We're excited to get to campus to be able to help fill this need. Thank you for praying with us that God will quickly get us there!

We have really enjoyed the opportunity to be raising support in California during this time. Last week we got to celebrate Faye's dad's 60th birthday and this past weekend her grandmother's 90th!!! With our wedding
