## Over Spring Break, Jeanne came to Christ!!!

Brodie (my teammate) and I met Jeanne at the beginning of this semester, when we were on campus one day, asking students to share with us about their spiritual experience. Jeanne invited us to sit down with her in a campus cafe where she was studying, and began to tell us about how **she had been questioning for a decade** what happened after death. We had a wonderful conversation with her that winter day, and as Brodie and I left the cafe we commented to each other, "God is definitely at work in Jeanne's life". We were very excited to see it!

Over the course of the past semester, Brodie and I continued to meet with Jeanne, just about every week, to discuss her questions about spirituality and talk about the Bible with her. It turned out that Jeanne had, despite her atheist/Buddhist upbringing, ended up with a whole bunch of Christian friends in college, and she was very curious about the God they claimed to know. She has a tender heart and a beautiful openness about her, and as we talked with her every week, it became very apparent that **Jeanne had a deep desire** to know God. My times with Jeanne, talking about Jesus, answering questions about Him, sharing our hearts and our spiritual experiences, were always the highlights of my week.

Jeanne went with another Brown Christian organization down to New Orleans to do Hurricane Katrina relief work for Spring Break. In her words, she wanted to spend her break with others with whom she could "think about her questions about God". And when I had dinner with her the week after, she told me that some time that week she had realized that she had come to believe, not only in God's existence, but that she could have—and wanted—a relationship with Him through Jesus.

I cried for a couple of days after hearing that from her—there are students at Brown who are searching for God! He is rescuing people here! We've seen one other woman, after a two-year journey, put her trust in Christ this semester, and there are many others who are spiritually searching with whom our staff and students are sharing the gospel and their lives.
