Got 30 Seconds?

Tomorrow is the first day of school. Ahhhh!!!

We've been in high-gear the past few weeks trying to get ready for the fall to start. This past week we did our annual fall survey of the freshman class. We call it "Got 30 Seconds?" and it's a really short survey on what their spiritual interests are. We use this survey not only to get a feel for where the freshman class is coming from, but to find out who is potentially interested getting involved with our group or talking further about spiritual things. We got a great response: 629 people (85% freshmen) took our survey (more than half of the class of 2009), and more than half are interested in something that we have to offer. We're really excited. We had a drawing for free pizzas as an incentive for people to take the survey, and tonight we're going to deliver gift certificates for those free pizzas. Freshman outreach has begun.

The average response from the 629 students surveyed was 3.04 on a scale from 1 to 5 (5 being a really strong desire). My sense from talking with students is that desire for spiritual exploration/development decreases during their time at Dartmouth, so we're trying to catch the students early!

74 students said that they're interested in helping to get one of these discussion groups started. Woo hoo! All last year we were trying to get some of these groups started on campus, but because of a lack of student initiative and a lack of staff, we couldn't get them off the ground. This year we're starting with 74 students who want to help us kick them off. Many of these students are not Christians, so these groups are sure to be interesting!
