## Macon and Dale head back to the Philippines

Macon is heading to the Philippines with photographer Dale Stroud June 3-20. You know he and Dale have made numerous trips together to get outstanding photos and video that you enjoy at [ntm.org](http://ntm.org) and [NTM@Work](mailto:NTM@Work) magazine; all to bring to life what God is doing among tribal peoples all over the world.

Now, Macon and Dale will be documenting the NTM Philippines Disaster Relief project for tribal people who lost homes, fishing boats and livelihood. In the first days of the typhoon NTM Aviation made numerous helicopter and plane flights to bring in urgently needed food and medical supplies to the stranded island people. Now NTM is dedicating long-term care for these same people. Materials are being shipped in to build 100 homes, and 40 fishing boats. Fishnets will be provided for the families to catch fish for their food.

This type of long-term commitment is akin to what we do in Discipleship, Church planting and Bible translation. The benefits are mature Christians and Churches that are now capable of sending their own tribal missionaries. And that is AWESOME.
