When missionaries first came to Hermon's village, Hermon was an alcoholic, womanizing, young tribal man with no future but to end his life like so many Guanano men, in drunken fights, clan vengeance, or working the cocaine fields of unscrupulous men. But Hermon listened well to the teachings of God's Word in his language. He believed and became a strong teacher to his own people. Now Hermon is helping other Guanano men and women hear the 'Good News' of Christ's coming, death, burial and resurrection.

Like Hermon, the lives of tribal men and women all around the world are being transformed by the work of NTM missionaries teaching the Word of God in the tribal language. You, like Hermon, *listened well* to God's call to reach the unreachable and **because of your partnership God is changing lives.**
