Over the past two months, I've had the opportunity to speak to students in Toronto, Pennsylvania, Florida, Wisconsin and South Africa, where I've both challenged them with this simple message and encouraged them to share this simple message. God has been at work! Over 100 students have put their faith in Christ as their Savior at these events.

After traveling from Orlando to Atlanta, and then a 15 hour flight to South Africa, I got off the plane and three hours later was speaking at a youth rally for our good friend Mark Tittley. He asked if I'd be willing to share the gospel... an offer I would never refuse. Five churches had

gathered together for the event, with over 100 students attending. I spoke about moments that terrify us, some of the crazy phobias that people have, and then shared a verse from the Bible that can be terrifying. In Matthew 7:21-23 Jesus says, "Depart from me, I never knew you." I told the students that eternal life is not about what we DO, but about who we KNOW. After explaining the simple message of the G.O.S.P.E.L., 20 students responded by putting their faith in Christ.

Paul's words in Romans 1:16 ring true, "I am not ashamed of the gospel of Jesus Christ, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes."

My testimony of how I was discipled as a 15 year old, how I learned to study God's Word, pray and share my faith through my discipler, gave Florence's youth leaders both confidence and inspiration to fully engage in the lives of their students. 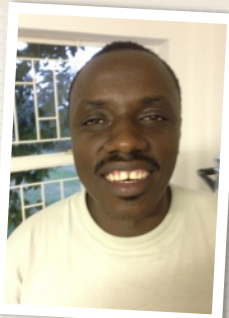
