

Energizing Students to Impact their World!

This Summer Sonlife partnered with Dare 2 Share to equip and energize almost 1500 students in Evangelism and Disciple-Making at Lead The Cause. Our team participated in events in Chicago, Austin, Denver, Washington DC, and Orange County, CA.

The Chicago event was hosted at my alma mater, Wheaton College. What a thrill to tell stories of some of the great alumni who were impacted on that campus: Billy & Ruth Graham, Jim Elliot, Todd Beamer. I had the opportunity to share the personal significance of Wheaton as Jennifer's great grandmother, Corrine Smith, was the Dean of Women while the Graham's the Smithsonian Museums in spiritual

were students there. Students were bused from Wheaton to downtown Chicago for outreach in the afternoons, where they had the opportunity to engage over one thousand people in spiritual conversations.

In Washington, DC, we designed a prayer experience around the memorials and monuments, culminating with students sitting on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial, writing a letter to God about the legacy they wanted their life to leave. We partnered with the DC Dream Center for an afternoon of outreach in inner city DC, and also had an afternoon to engage tourists visiting

conversations. Students ended their week thinking about the eternal in Arlington Cemetery and writing a gospel letter to a spiritually lost friend back home.

Lead The Cause finished out with a week in Orange County on the campus of Vanguard University, which is a converted Air Force base. Students did their outreach experiences at the nearby beaches, and the week culminated with a commissioning service at the beach. Some students wanted to get baptized, and when some curious onlookers asked what was going on, they heard the gospel, trusted Christ, and were baptized on the spot!


GROWING TEAM
