ORPHANAGE EXPANSION

Construction has begun on our new boy's dormitory wing at Open Door. The new wing will expand our capacity, allowing us to provide a home for 50-60 children. Construction should be completed by the

end of the year, with projects like painting, electrical and building bunk beds available for team projects in early 2015.



SOYM TRAINING CENTER

Our seventh year of SOYM began the first week of September with 15 students. Before our SOYM Training Center can be used by the students, we have a few



projects left to complete. One of those, installing a well so we have water for the bathrooms and kitchen, is in process now. After installing tile, plumbing & electrical, the Training Center will be ready to open.

SCHOOL EXPANSION

Our school in Bois De Lance continues to grow, with nearly 500 students enrolled for the 2014-15 school year. Open Door has added a secondary school, with classes for 7th thru 9th grade currently available. A

new classroom wing is being added this Fall to alleviate crowding as some of our classes have over 50 students in a



15x20 room. We're also hoping to finish the school Library soon. We already have computers donated for this space, which will open up a new world of learning and discovery for the children in the village.



On my recent trip to Haiti, Pastor Wiljean and I baptized 15 believers in the ocean just outside Cap Haitien. What a powerful reminder of the impact we are having as we transform a nation...

one life at a time.!

The next 8 days are a microcosm of our Fall... the craziest Fall in our 15 years of ministry living in Florida.

Since Jennifer and I celebrated our 22nd Anniversary in Savannah, GA in August, I've launched our SOYM program in Haiti and been with youth leaders in Louisville, Kansas City, Seattle, Portland, Lincoln and Denver. I've also spoken at youth events in Nebraska and Crestview (Pensacola), Florida.

The Power of the Gospel...

In Nebraska, after training church leaders is Sonlife's Muvement Seminar on how to build a disciple making ministry, I spoke for a local youth ministry. Of the fifty students that attended their regular Wednesday night program, seven responded to the message by putting their trust in Christ for eternal life.

In Crestview, fifteen local youth ministries gathered for a See You At The Pole (national youth ministry day



of prayer around school flag poles) rally. Almost 500 students packed the church for the event where I challenged them to be

campus missionaries and take the Gospel to their schools. But before you can share the Gospel with others, you have to know the Gospel for yourself. Almost seventy students indicated putting their faith in Christ alone for salvation that night!

Besides the youth leader training events over the next eight days in Phoenix, San Diego and Minnesota, I'll also be training leaders at events in Columbus, Chicago, DC, Dallas and St. Louis before Thanksgiving and speaking at Shamineau Camp in MN to 400 students and the Church of God state youth conference to about 1000 students in Orlando.
