
HAPPY THANKSGIVING

THE JOY OF LIVING WITH OPEN HANDS

e cannot say thank you enough for your investment in our ministry and our family. God has used you, our ministry partners and friends, to continually pour out His blessing on our lives. As we receive, we want to continue to live with open hands, being conduits that allow God's blessing to flow into the lives of others.

On my recent trip to Haiti, I was asked to speak on the subject of giving. While it might seem odd to speak on giving to people living in a country that is the poorest in the western hemisphere, it is a message we all need to be reminded of.

The Apostle Paul gives us specific encouragement about giving in 2 Corinthians 9. First, Paul says that we should be *prepared* to give,

eager and ready with open hearts, open eyes and open hands.

Second, Paul speaks to God's provision that enables us to give. Instead of waiting for God to provide before deciding to give, we see through the law of sowing and reaping that our giving actually unlocks the floodgates of God's blessing into our lives. By giving, we are "made rich in every way so that we can be generous on every occasion." When we give, God blesses, increasing our capacity to give even more.

Finally, Paul says that our giving results in *praise*. God is glorified. People are blessed and thankful. Giving opens doors for the Gospel of Christ!

UPDATES FROM HAITI

Hurricane Tomas, Cholera, Chaos

As if Haiti hadn't been hit hard enough this year, the recent hurricane that



plowed through southern Haiti and flooded the streets in the north has added to the misery and despair. Just yesterday, the

cholera outbreak (made worse by the flooding) caused rioting against the UN peacekeepers in Cap Haitien. Rumors are swirling that the UN forces brought cholera to Haiti from Asia. Pray for Open Door Haiti as we respond to the crisis.



Young Leaders Making A Difference

Sonel, Peterson and Samson graduated from our SOYM leadership training program in Haiti this year. Moses is enrolled in SOYM this fall and will graduate next June. These great young leaders are all involved on the worship team at their church, help to lead their youth ministries, and assist with ministry and serve as interpreters for visiting mission teams. This Fall they began teaching english classes at Open Door School twice a week. What a thrill to see God using them to impact so many lives.



Open Door Orphanage

Construction on the orphanage project at Open Door continues to progress. The walls are up! We are now ready for teams to come and put the roof on the building. This will be a 2-3 week project and teams are eager to come, but the cholera outbreak has caused many to postpone. The outbreak isn't in our village, or even in Cap Haitien yet, but we understand the caution and know the orphanage will be completed on God's timetable, not ours.



Medical Teams

God continues to bless Open Door Medical Clinic. This year, the clinic has added a second doctor to its staff and expanded its laboratory services. A recent medical team brought three pediatricians, three nurses, a pharmacy technician, a dentist and a few medical students. The dentist has everything we need to open a dental office at the clinic and is willing to ship it on a container when we are ready. He wants to train Haitian clinic staff to perform basic dental procedures and have a dentist-ready room for visiting teams of dentists & hygienists.
