Twelve years ago, a long held dream came to fruition as the School Of Youth Ministry was birthed in Haiti. The year-long disciple-making training program for emerging ministry leaders began, appropriately, with twelve in the first group, like Jesus with His initial Twelve.

The one year training program has blossomed into a full four year Bible School, with over fifty students being trained this year, including 22 in the first year SOYM program. Many of the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th year students are pastors of Open Door Churches across Haiti. Twelve years ago, when we began, Open Door had only two Today, there are 26, churches. with two more being planted by the end of the year. Each year, the SOYM students help with these church planting efforts, with many going on to pastor the churches that are planted.

The School Of Youth Ministry has produced much fruit, as Jesus prayed His disciples would.



GROWING STRONGER TO GO WIDER

When I stepped into the Executive Director role for Sonlife in July 2013, the ministry was relaunching and had one full time and one part time staff member. No one else was added to the team for the first couple years as we evaluated where we had been to clarify our direction moving forward. With a clear vision to "transform the culture of ministry in North America, restoring it to the disciple-making heart of Jesus," and with a clear pathway to :equip leaders in relational disciple-making according to the Son's life," others began to rally to the cause. Fast forward to our Staff Retreat in the mountains of Oregon this September... 18 of us gathered to dream and pray together about how we can grow stronger to go wider with our disciple-making vision!
