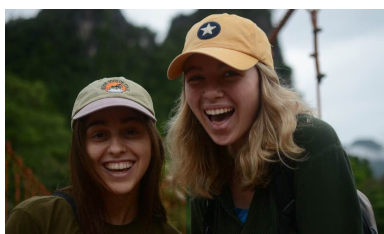


# SOUTHEAST ASIA TRIP

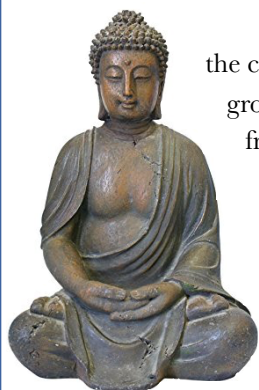

## IGNITING THE NEXT GENERATION

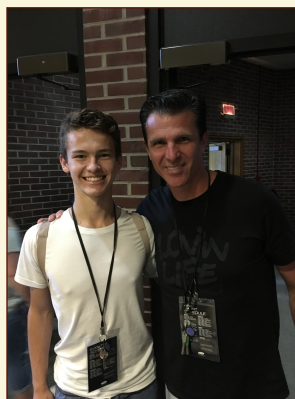
Lead The Cause is a week long evangelism training conference for High School Students. This training partnership between Sonlife Ministries and Dare 2 Share took place this Summer in Chicago, Austin, Denver and D.C., with over 1250 students being equipped to share their faith and make disciples. I had the privilege of speaking at the Chicago and D.C. events while members of our Sonlife Leadership Team were in Austin and Denver.

Youth Pastors and Leaders that we train throughout the year in disciple-making at our Sonlife Strategy Seminar, 4 Chair Discipling Seminar and Foundations Seminar are coached in how to BE disciple-makers, BUILD disciple-making ministries and BEGIN disciple-making movements. Lead The Cause is a critical component to this process, helping leaders know how to implement disciple-making priorities within their ministries.

## DISCIPLE-MAKING TOGETHER

The Evangelical Covenant Church, based in Chicago, is seeking help from Sonlife to implement a disciple-making strategy throughout their denomination. In July, I flew to Chicago to train and certify their leadership team in 4 Chair Discipling and strategize the training roll out.

Through the miracle of technology, I trained and coached church leaders in Finland with Sonlife's 4 Chair Discipling Seminar, using Zoom video conferencing. We'll follow up with a coaching call after they train 4 Chairs to their churches. One day, I hope to visit them in Finland for more training together.
