READY TO RESCUE

Amazingly, 50 years ago, the American Red Cross taught swimming lessons... outside the pool. Then they discovered that people learn better when people actually get wet.

When it comes to making disciples, the church has long thought that we could disciple people inside the four walls of the church. Invite them to a thirteen week "discipleship class" and three months later, POOF! You have a disciple of Jesus. But disciples aren't made in classrooms, are they? Disciples are made when they jump into the pool, where their faith must be tested with real life experiences and real relationships. As much as possible, we try to take our training and teaching outside the classroom where our students will actually "get wet."

Our SOYM students in Haiti are immediately put in situations where they must use what they learn. When we train them to share their faith (evangelize the lost), we actually send them out into the village where people are drowning in their sin. Our students have even had the privilege of sharing the gospel with witch doctors, rescuing some as they have put their faith in Christ. Our SOYM students don't just learn about Christ's priorities in making disciples, they each must have their own disciples that they pass along everything they learn to. And they are helping to plant churches too.

Jesus often put his disciples in uncomfortable situations where their faith was tested and their mission-commitment was galvanized. He threw them in the "deep end of the pool," preparing them for a life of rescuing the perishing.

When you and I take up our cross to follow our Master, He will lead us too on many rescue missions. Are you ready?
It's time to get wet!
