The mission and vision of DHM has been crafted and shaped largely through the influence of Sonlife in my ministry and leadership development. Being asked to step into the Executive Director role for Sonlife is a wonderful fit for my gifts, passions and calling... a natural expression of who God has made me to be and what God has called me to do.

INSPIRE: Through my leadership role with Sonlife and my growing relationship with Dare2Share, there will be increased opportunities to inspire students and leaders alike with the message of the Gospel and our disciple making mandate. I'll be

putting an even greater emphasis now on speaking at leadership conferences where I can champion the priority and practice of disciple making from the life of Christ to church leaders and students (Sonlife's MUVE conferences in Chicago & Portland in 2014, D2S LTCU event in Dennver, 2014).

INSTRUCT: I will be training our Sonlife Strategy Seminar, a basic introduction to disciple making from the life of Christ, in Orlando, Portland and Seattle over the next two months. My goal is to personally train the Strategy Seminar in 10-12 locations in 2014 (would your church be interested?), and our leadership team hopes to train the seminar in 20-25 locations next year.

Current projects are also underway to develop new disciple making training resources and tools for students and leaders that will be released in 2014.

INVOLVE: One of my chief responsibilities as Executive Director for Sonlife is to build a leadership team of regional directors, speakers, trainers, coaches, and organizational support. We currently have 2 regional staff... I'm praying for God to raise up 8 more so that we can effectively provide training, coaching and mentoring for 10 regions across the U.S.

I'm also working on strategic partnerships with other youth ministry organizations (Dare2Share, CRU, Christian Surfers, Youth For Christ Canada, Global Link, etc.) and church denominations to expand Sonlife's training footprint.

IGNITE: Our passion is to be a part of a movement of disciples making disciples to the ends of the earth!

Dreaming Big In Malawi..

MALAWI TRIP UPDATE / AUG 19-26



St. Michaels and All Angels Church Blantyre, Malawi



J-Life Malawi was able to purchase land for a ministry training center and with the help of a church in North Carolina have begun construction.

Building On A Strong Foundation: J-Life Malawi's leadership team took me to see the first church started in Malawi after David Livingston brought the gospel to the country in 1848. Livingston pioneered the spread of the gospel throughout Africa and the city where J-Life is based in Malawi, Blantyre, fittingly was named after his birthplace in Scotland.

Disciples Making Disciples: Connex, our J-Life Malawi Country Leader, discipled his younger brother Praise. Praise now serves on the J-Life Malawi leadership team, and one of his disciples has joined the team in the past year. As they keep multiplying leaders, the vision is to expand to all five regions and 28 districts across Malawi.

Expanding To Impact A Nation: J-Life is in the midst of building a training center where they can run a program like what we're doing in Haiti with SOYM. The first building, a multi-purpose facility with dining/meeting space and offices, is being funded with the help of a church in the US. They hope to build 6-8 bungalows, each costing \$10,000-15,000 and housing 8-12 people, to use for training, conferences, youth camps and hosting mission teams. Would your church like to build a bungalow in Malawi?
