## Lead The Cause... A Disciple Making Movement!

Long time friend Greg Stier (Founder of Dare 2 Share) and I spoke together at three student evangelism training conferences this Summer. Students in Chicago, Denver and Portland were equipped every day in evangelism and apologetics and then sent out onto the streets of the city to share their faith.

About 1000 students were trained in the three cities, and during their 5 day training events they had almost 3000 Gospel conversations. How exciting to see God use these 13-18 year olds to lead almost 150 people to faith in Christ! And that is just the beginning.

At each event, students wrote letters to friends back home to share Christ

with them. One of the most moving moments in each city was when we collected all these letters and prayed over them, trusting God for the salvation of each friend and family member that would be receiving a letter. Some attending the conference had received a letter from a friend last year, trusted in Christ, and were now being trained to share the good news with others. Katie Payne wrote a sample letter for the students in Denver... a real letter that she planned to send to a friend back home. The week after the conference, Katie's friend received the letter, talked with Katie about it, and put her faith in Christ as Savior!

Speaking from John 3 about Jesus' critical interaction with Nicodemus, a leader of the Pharisees, I wore a Jewish prayer shawl and explained the Pharisees' view of righteousness being earned by keeping the law. We cannot attain righteousness by keeping the law though. We're lawbreakers! Jesus brought a message of GRACE. It is not thru what you DO, but rather thru what Christ has already DONE, that we are made righteous in God's eyes. We are saved by grace alone. Does our gospel pass the "grace alone" test?

I've seen it in cities across the US. God is raising up a generation to change the world... with the Gospel of Grace!

## MINISTRY SUPPORT


As our ministry needs continue to grow, we would like to increase our monthly support by \$500 by the end of 2014.
