New Staff at ODH

Last January, I was overwhelmed with the burden of responsibility leading Open Door Haiti. Many have been praying for God to bring help. The mountain was big, since it would require others feeling called to be missionaries and raise support like our family does. In the past three months, God has brought on two staff families at ODH to help me in the areas of Communications, Missions and Fund Development. God is moving this mountain!

Orphanage Funding

One of the enormous burdens we felt for Open Door at the beginning of the year was the funding needs for the new orphanage opened last December. Our funds were running out and we needed \$3500 a month to meet the ongoing needs. Though we still don't have all the orphan sponsors we need, we have never been short on orphanage funds. God is moving this mountain!

U.S. Opportunities

A new partnership was forged this Summer with Dare2Share that will provide a platform for more speaking & training with students here in the US. This was in direct answer to our prayers. We were asking God to ease the leadership burden with ODH, allowing me a greater focus in evangelism, my passion. God moved another mountain.

DISCIPLEMAKING TRAINING INITIATIVES

J-Life East Africa



DHM has made the commitment to support the country leaders of our training initiatives in Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, Tanzania & Zanzibar. Each of these leaders is serving full-time, living by faith, trusting God to meet their needs. We are currently sending \$400 a month to help these leaders, or about \$5000 for the year. We would love to send more, helping leaders train leaders, as God provides.



Tagbanwa Project / Philippines

Our focus among the Tagbanwa tribe for the past five years has been training church leaders and youth leaders in disciplemaking principles and strategies. One of our key Tagbanwa leaders, Pastor Randy Cong, is a friend that we have helped over the years, providing him with a laptop, a camera and other ministry tools. We would love to provide regular support of \$50 a month to help Randy with his ministry. We also provide scholarship funds for 3 Tagbanwa children to attend high school. Besides travel costs, our ministry support goal for the Tagbanwa is \$1500 a year.



School Of Youth Ministry

We are in our fifth year of the SOYM program in Haiti. We have trained over 50 leaders to date. These young leaders have assisted with church planting, youth ministry, evangelism & discipleship and other ministry projects. Through DHM, we raise \$500 per SOYM student to scholarship them for this leadership training program. We are currently raising funds (\$15.000) to finish construction on our SOYM Training Center.



We are partnering together with D2S to develop training and equip students and leaders with tools and strategies to share the Gospel and initiate disciplemaking movements across the US. D2S has also opened the door for DHM to bring their training to any of the countries we currently minister in, as well as connect us with new groups interested in D2S internationally. Just like the D2S evangelism conference I did in Cameroon this past August, I'd love to bring D2S training to students in every country I travel to in 2013. The training materials and conference costs for this effort will be about \$1500.
