At the heart of our ministry is an army of churches and volunteers who support our work in Haiti by praying, giving and going! Churches all across the US (FL, OH,, AZ, IA, NJ, MN, IL, VA, NC, NE, IN...) have all partnered together with us. Many have sent teams. Others have hosted a child sponsorship weekend. Some are supporting our missionaries, or raising funds for relief or other projects. We could not accomplish all that God has laid before us without the church here in the US coming alongside the church in Haiti, locking arms, and laboring together.

Northland, A Church Distributed

One of our newest partners is Northland, the home church of Todd and Gina McLennan, our newest missionary staff. Along with supporting Todd and Gina as missionaries, Northland invited Open Door to have a ministry booth at their Missions Weekend recently to promote trips targeted at Northland attenders. Northland sends out dozens



of teams throughout the year all across the world and now Open Door will be their official ministry partner to send teams to in Haiti.

Safe Harbor Christian Church

Safe Harbor has adopted Open Door as one its official mission partners, putting ODH in their mission's budget. But they want to do more than

SCHOOL UPDATE: 1ST SEMESTER THE



LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION Our school in Bois De Lance is expanding with a new office, storage, and library building. The library will enhance the children's education, allowing them to read a variety of books and expand their horizons. We are currently collecting books... creole, french and english titles.

NEW FEEDING PROGRAM

This Fall, we expanded our feeding program to our school in Quanaminthe, where almost 400 children are now receiving a nutritious meal each day at school. Our school in the remote mountain village of Maguayave just received their shipment of food to begin feeding as well.

R THE GIFT OF A GOAT



HELPING FAMILIES This past Christmas, we had several families here in the US donate funds so that the families of the children they are sponsoring in Haiti could be given a goat. The goats produce milk, as well as offspring, that can be sold to help provide income for impoverished families. Often, it is the sponsor children themselves who are given the family responsibility to care for the new goat.

FUTURE FARMERS

Other gifts came in this Christmas to help families expand on their farming initiatives, where vegetables can be grown to be sold in the market at a premium price.
