

The Fall has been busy with trips to train and meet with leaders in Haiti, Houston, Kenya, Portland, Toronto, Pittsburgh and Detroit. I've been busy working with our Sonlife Leadership Team putting together our upcoming D•Conference for January. In preparation for that, we've been working on developing new training (4 Chair Discipling) and new resources (40 Days of Disciple-Making Journal) to serve as a catalyst for our disciple-making efforts across North America. God is using these efforts to impact leaders and students... He is faithful!



"Whoever claims to live in him must walk as Jesus did." 1 John 2:6

The phrase What Would Jesus Do?' became popular arong Christians in the United Statism in the 1970 KWWD bracelets, necklaces, bookmarks, plaques and coffee mugs ware averywhare. It was a marketing bonanzal The Ida was imple. Before you do or asy any any ting, simply ads yoursal, "What would Jesus do?' Than just do it The movement was inspired by Charles Sheldon's 1964 book. If Nis Staps, subtited What Would Jesus Do? In the fittional book, Sheldon talls the story of the transformation that takes place in one person's Ifs, and as a result, in their church and in their community, as a result of sting this simple existion.

Now I have a confession to make. I wore a WWJD bracelet. As a youth pastor, I bought the WWJD curriculum and taught it to my students. It was both inspiring and convicting. In fact, I ordered an entire bag of WWJD bracelets so all my students could wear one.

But what if 'What Would Jesus Do?' was the wrong question to ask. Instead of WWJD, wouldn't we be better served to consider WDJD. Shouldn't we be asking. "What Did Jesus Do?"

We often look at the Gospels as a collection of stories about Jesus. In them, we find the message of Jasus. We see what he taught. We marvel at his words. Meybe we find the methods of Jasus. We see what he did. We are amazed by his minicelas. And so wer're in awe dive worship him as our Lord. But imitating Jesus? Now that's impossible, right?

t look at what Jesus said to his disciples.

"I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you." John 13:15 What were Jesus' expectations of his followers?

We need to see Jesus for more than just his message and his methods. We need to see him as our model. More than just modeling what to say and what to do, Jesus modeled how to live.

From what you know of Jesus' life on earth, write down some thoughts on how you think Jesus walked (lived). How was Jesus able to do what he did?

For those of us who feel like it is an impossible challenge to 'walk as Jasus walked', listen to his words to the disciples who were with him day after day for three and a half years and witnessed his racical low, emazing teaching and awe-inspiring miracles first hend.
