

Kids Against Hunger

Open Door's two schools now have almost 500 students enrolled. Of these, only 200 have been sponsored. We have had a growing burden this fall. How can we possibly feed all these kids?

At the beginning of November, I met with a man named Larry, who directs a ministry called Kids Against Hunger. They package and provide food for poverty-stricken kids around the world. Larry promised that if we could cover the shipping, they could get us all the food we needed, for as long as we needed.

On November 11th, two pallets of food, enough to feed the children for two months, showed up at Open Door.
