THE POWER OF THE GOSPEL



CAMEROON ~ CENTRAL AFRICA

Florence, the National Director of J-LIFE Cameroon, had been begging me to come to her country and help her leadership team as they develop a strategy to effectively launch disciple-making youth ministries across Cameroon. Since I love to speak to students, I offered to do that as well if she could use me. And use me she did!

Exhausted after a crazy flight that took me from Orlando to Montreal to Brussels to Cameroon, I literally hit the ground running, spending my first two days training at their National Leadership Conference. Then I spoke in two churches on Sunday before beginning their three day Youth Conference Monday. My last day was spent in strategic planning with J-LIFE'S national leadership team.

My highlight, by far, was the Student Conference. I did two sessions training the students in Evangelism. 80% of them had never shared their faith before. On Day One, I sent the students out to initiate conversations and see what God would do. They shared the Gospel with almost 70 people, with 19 putting their trust in Christ. One young girl was terrified and about to give up, but then she sensed God telling her to talk to one lady. The lady told her, "I'll give you two minutes." Well, those two minutes changed both their lives. I wish you all could have heard her testimony, declaring, "Sharing the gospel is so easy. I want to do it every day the rest of my life!"

Day Two was even more amazing. The 40 youth and their leaders shared the gospel with about 120 people, with 66 putting their trust in Christ. 85 trusting Christ in two day? Wow!



CCU ATHLETES & DARE2SHARE

Darren Richie, a friend from NJ and current Athletic Director at Colorado Christian University, invited me to speak at their annual Athlete's Retreat. Over 220 student athletes gathered for the weekend in the mountains of Colorado, with about 20 making commitments to trust Christ as their Savior and many more dealing with struggles and sins that were holding them back from fully following Christ.
