
Disciple-Making Partnerships (cont)

A highlight of YMEC this year was the group of students from an urban ministry in Baltimore that were invited in to sit on a panel and share with us as leaders about the challenges facing their generation as well as the hope of a vision for students embracing the call of God on their lives. It was a powerful moment as members from the panel of students then each sat at our tables with us as leaders to interact, asking and responding to questions, and praying together. While we have greater alignment with some of these ministries than others, we still praise God for the diversity of ministries committed to reaching this generation!

Disciple-Making Alliance

Modeled after Concentric, which is our relational network of global disciple-making partners like J-Life Africa, Josiah Venture (Europe), and Singular (Latin America) who all share the same disciple-making DNA based upon the model of Jesus, we are in the beginning stages of developing a relational network of like-minded ministries here in North America.
