Training Leaders, Transforming a Nation

THE **S**CHOOL **O**F **Y**OUTH **M**INISTRY BEGINS ITS 10TH YEAR

It was shortly after my first trip to Haiti in 2003 that I began to dream of partnering together with Pastor Wiljean Compere to start a training center at Open Door Haiti to equip young leaders for ministry. At that time, I had no idea what a Training Center would look like. I'd never seen one. I only had a dream. Then, in 2007 I made my first trip to South Africa to visit J-Life Ministries' Disciple-Making Training Center. John Abrahamse, now a dear friend, had been running J-Life's Training Center on his family's farm since 2000.

Armed with a dream, and now a clear picture of what it might look like, Pastor Wiljean and I began to lay the groundwork for the School Of Youth Ministry. It would target young Haitian emerging leaders, and it would be a residential program that would combine classroom training with hands on ministry experiences and character-shaping community.

We had helped raise funds the year before so that Open Door Church could build a Mission House to host teams that came to serve. Now, we would raise more funds to build a second floor on the Mission House to house the new training program, the School Of Youth Ministry (or SOYM).

SOYM's core training would be built around Sonlife's disciple-making training for leaders, which J-Life had already translated into French for the francophone countries in Africa. I would bring other ministry friends, Sonlife Trainers from the US, to help me teach, and hopefully their churches would get behind SOYM and scholarship some of the students (\$500 per year).

That was ten years ago. We've now trained over 120 emerging Haitian leaders through SOYM. They are having a significant impact! When we began SOYM, Open Door had only two churches. Today, there are eighteen! And the most exciting part about that growth is that 16 of the 18 churches are being pastored by SOYM graduates! Not only that.... The Medical Center and
