### Global Leadership Gathering in Ephesus, Turkey

Six continents were represented at the global leadership gathering I participated in earlier this month. We met at a conference center on the Aegean Sea just fifteen minutes from the historic ruins of first century Ephesus. While much of our time was spent sharing with and sharpening one another for the movements we help to lead, we also took the opportunity to tour Ephesus and Pergamum, two of the seven churches from Asia Minor Jesus addressed in Revelation 2-3. In December 2020, as I was finishing up reading through the Bible in a year, I found m myself in Revelation 2, meditating on Jesus' words of affirmation for the faithfulness and perseverance of the Ephesian church. But He had

this against them. They had forgotten their first love. Jesus was inviting me then to rekindle a first love intimacy with Him. Walking the stone streets of ancient Ephesus, a "random" heart-shaped rock

The hope is that we would have 250 disciple-making leaders from 120 countries for that leadership summit. Back in 2015, almost 200 leaders from 53 countries gathered at our last summit in Israel.
