School Of Youth Ministry, Class of 2009

(SOYM) in Haiti has been one of the most significant and rewarding experiences of my twenty-plus years of ministry! I wept tears of joy at our recent SOYM graduation. I have an affection for these young men as if they were my own sons.

After their four months of intensive training where they were discipled as leaders, SOYM's 12 students were sent back to their churches to work with their Pastors in fulfilling their ministry assignments. Each of them led a small group, trained leaders, conducted outreaches, took a missions trip. In all, these 12 young men led over 200 people to faith in Jesus Christ during their six month internship. Donnson, one of the graduates, shared the story of how he had shared the gospel with a young man on the street. After the young man prayed to receive Christ as his Savior, they were walking along the road when they approached a friend of the young man.
