We flew from Orlando to New York, then to Tokyo (that flight was 14 hours), then to Manila. Eight hours later we were boarding a plane for Palawan, where we got on a small plane to fly into the Tagbanwa tribe. Our friends Lyka, Peah and Melvira, who our family sponsors for school, were waiting for us when we arrived in the village. They speak a little english, and we brought gifts for them and did nails together, so it was really fun to be with them.

Palawan is so beautiful, and the people are really nice. I did get sick one night, which wasn't fun :(I loved the children so much. Jessica (to the right of me in the picture below) had fallen in a fire when she was a baby. She had a scar on her head. I showed her the scar on my leg from my accident when I was three. It was so cool. She looked at our scars, and then she said to me, "We are beautiful!" Michelle and Cecile are twin sisters that are both deaf, so I had fun using the sign language I am learning at school this year, even though its not the same as theirs.

I (Marisa) had wanted to go back to the Philippines ever since my trip with my Dad when I was 12. We helped our team clear trees and bushes for a new landing strip. That was really hard work! We also got to help with a VBS program where we played with the kids, loved on them and taught them how much God loves them. I loved taking lots of pictures of the kids and of all the beauty there is to see on the island. Going to different places, meeting different people, learning about different cultures, experiencing new things, seeing how BIG our God is...what a great adventure!

Disciplemaking Trainers Making An Impact!

While in South Africa for J-Life's African Leadership Summit, I had the opportunity to be with leaders from all five East African nations (Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, Tanzania & Burundi, along with the island of Zanzibar). Their stories of commitment and impact Shinga, our leader in humbled me. Rwanda, was told that if he came to South Africa for extended ministry training to lead J-Life Rwanda, he would forfeit his church. Because his family lived in a small room behind the church, this meant not only losing his ministry, but also his home. He knows what God has called him to do. Shinga is trusting God for a home for his family while he launches J-Life for the youth of his country!

A Village Finds Christ

Responding to training they had received from me three years earlier, some Tagbanwan youth leader trainers felt prompted by God to build a relationship with people in a village who had never been exposed to the Gospel. Of the 70 people living in the village, over 30 became Christians. One young man from the village who didn't know how to read or write wanted to enter the year long training program. Trainers spent the first two months teaching him how to read and write, and at graduation, while he was sharing his testimony, one leader leaned over and told me this young man was now their best Bible teacher!

Disciples Making Disciples

As we invest in leaders like Shinga from Rwanda, Randy from Palawan and the students in our SOYM program in Haiti, we are seeing God do miraculous things. In the first three months of their SOYM internship, this year's students in Haiti have led over 200 people to Christ through their disciplemaking efforts! Yea God!
