Words cannot begin to express our appreciation for you!

Let me unpack what this means.

Eriko and I will retire in Sendai, Japan. We recently purchased a home here. Three of our four children currently live in Japan so we will be close to four of our grandkids!

We are asking you our supporters to continue to send in support through **December 31**st, **2025.** This will help us finish well.

I will continue Three Stream Ministries through counseling, coaching and mentoring leaders and consulting with churches and mission organizations.

Financing retirement

Between Social Security, savings, and retirement funds invested through WorldVenture and SIM USA, we will be in a good place.
