Sharing Hope in Shaky Times

t was 11:30 pm on March 16. I was asleep and Eriko was still awake. My iPhone suddenly started screaming with a loud, automated message: EARTHQUAKE! EARTHQUAKE! Sure enough in a few seconds, things started shaking, books fell and a few cups broke. It was a 7.4 temblor, centered off the coast of Fukushima. We have experienced many aftershocks since then. It was around the date of the 11th anniversary of our 2011 disaster, so people were already experiencing stress. We are fine, including Eriko's mom and our daughter and her family, as well as people in our church. Parts of the Fukushima coast near the damaged nuclear reactor were without water for a long time.

od has given us opportunities to share the hope of Jesus during these shaky times. Harumi was not able to attend Bible study for a while, but we are meeting again. He is currently undergoing dialysis so our study will be via LINE. Please



pray for his health, salvation and that he can learn how to use this technology.

Over the weekend of 4/9-10, we held a Kid's Kitchen Easter event and a harp concert. We had 65 kids from 33 families participate in an Easter egg hunt and receive food



packages. Many lingered and talked with church members. It was a beautiful warm day for this outdoor event on our sportscourt, which included cherry blossoms!

n Sunday afternoon, Catherine Porter, a professional harpist and missionary, gave a beautiful concert at our Orange (memory care) Cafe gathering. Roughly 60 people attended this event and heard a powerful Christ-centered presentation in song and testimony. Church members invited many of their friends who expressed their thanks for the privilege of hearing such uplifting and healing music.
