Summer missions are by far one of my favorite parts of my job! For the last four weeks, I had the privilege of co-leading our Epic Summer Missions trip to Wildwood, New Jersey for the second year in a row. This summer, we had 32 students join us from all over the nation as well as 20 staff.

All of our students found jobs on the Wildwoods boardwalk either at Morey's Pier as game/ride operators, in food services along the boardwalk, or in retail. It's incredible seeing how invested and excited they have been engaging with their co-workers and getting to know them. They have been spending time with them sharing life stories in hopes of bringing the gospel and God's story to each of them.

One of my highlights was going back to see Hamdi and Marcelina *(top right picture)*. We met last year and have kept in touch throughout this last year and getting to see them again was such a blessing. It was encouraging to continue building relationship with them and to continue to engage in spiritual conversations with them. They hired one of our students this year and she has been able to be a witness not only to them but to the other workers at Boardwalk's Best. Pray that I would continue to have conversations with them and share the love of Christ.

Our staff team left just a few days ago to attend our National Staff Conference in Colorado and in the last four weeks, we have seen 371 initiated conversations, 194 spiritual conversations, 33 gospel presentations, and 4 people enter into eternal life changing relationship with Jesus.
