

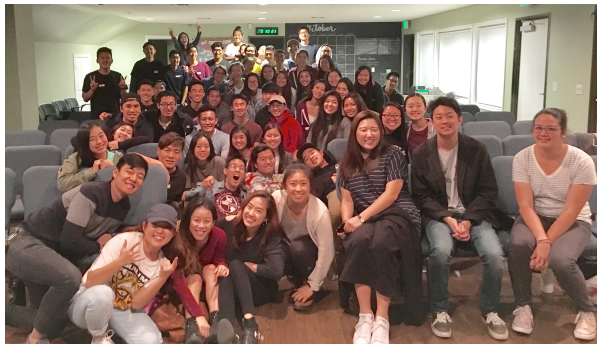
# ALOHA KE AKUA
