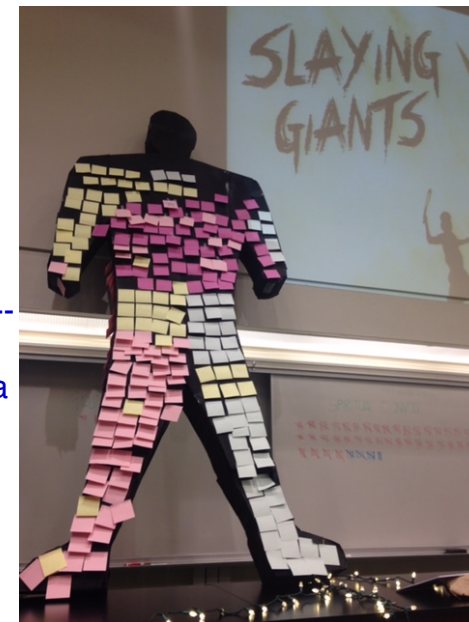
"GOD IS LOVE" – Slaying Giants
October 2015

October marks our annual Fall Outreach! Our hope and heart is to get as many students and faculty on our campus exposed to the gospel, giving them an opportunity to receive Jesus into their lives.

This year, we as staff came before our student leadership team and asked what they thought would be best for our movement. The team wanted to challenge our movement to first off, grow ourselves and to use this outreach as a means of equipping and empowering our own hearts to actively take steps to initiate spiritual conversations and share our faith. For some, it was their first time ever and for others it has just been something they have wanted to grow in more. No matter what the case, our prayer has been that our students would see the eternal impact they can make in the lives of their friends, families, classmates, professors, and more. Our hope is to help students in our movement see that initiating spiritual conversations can be done no matter what part of the journey we are on. It is also to help us grow in the understanding that we as Christians have an amazing opportunity and duty to share the good news with those around us.

Our "Slaying Giants" outreach was set up as a four-week initiative where each week, we would move towards personal goals of evangelism. We spent the first two weeks praying for opportunities and for the Lord to begin to soften the hearts of those on our campuses as well as for boldness and conviction in our own hearts. We then used one of our weekly meetings to take every student through some gospel tools to help them with initiating conversations. And then finally, we challenged each student and staff to set personal goals and "giants" they wanted to slay and trust God with by posting our fears on a 10-foot cardboard giant. We prayed and took steps to begin slaying giants in our lives and trusting that the Lord would use us.

Report: From November 3rd-10th, our students initiated over 240 spiritual conversations, had 8 Gospel presentations, and we saw one new sister make a decision to follow Christ! One of the things our student leadership and staff team are hoping and praying for is that this outreach would be a launching pad for our movement to begin living a life that 'fixes our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.' 2 Corinthians 4:18.
