My ears perked at that moment and I started to pray in my head for Brittany and that God would really meet her this weekend and that he would move her towards him! When arrived at camp, I told her that I was really excited she was here and if she wanted to talk at all throughout the weekend to ask questions or clarify things she was hearing, to not hesitate and just ask.

Saturday, September 19. 2015 - During free time Saturday afternoon, we all went into Haleiwa to check out the town and I had intentionally asked Brittany to hang out with me and a couple other students. It was fun getting to know her more and to get to hear more of her story and I was feeling the Spirit prompting me to share the gospel with her. Although there wasn't much opportunity to get too deep, when we got back to the retreat site, I mentioned to her that I wanted to share something with her later that night, so that I actually would.

That evening, after the message, we entered into a time of prayer and worship and it was then I felt the Spirit prompting me to ask if I would pray for her. As I was praying for her, we both began to cry. She shared how this weekend was the first time ever in her life where she has felt peace and even in not knowing anyone, has felt the most known. There was a freedom to share and not feel judged and because of that, there was a greater sense of the Lord at work. I kept wrestling with how to share the gospel with her and as I went back and forth, I kept thinking how I didn't want to miss giving her the opportunity to enter into a relationship with Jesus because he loves her so much. We talked about that and in the end, her words were, "I want it." We celebrated and I got to share that this was her new spiritual birthday. I can't begin to describe the feelings of joy that entered my heart and how at that point, nothing else mattered than seeing a life changed for eternity!
