For the first time ever, we have a team in Brooklyn, NY, reaching students for Christ. There are 25 campuses and this small team is focusing on 10 of them right now. On one of these campuses they met a group of over 200 students who are here from East Asia studying together. One of those students is Victoria. She had never heard of Jesus before, and after meeting with our team and doing some studies in the gospel of John, she has come to believe in Him.

In New Haven, CT, our Yale staff team has been reaching out to students on a nearby campus. Just since classes began in September, seven students have come to Christ and are part of a women's ministry group and are coming weekly to the Bible studies.

Students all over our region need to hear about Christ, and if they did, many of them would give their lives to Him. Others need help in overcoming obstacles they have to faith. Some are already Christians and need to link arms with other believers to grow in their own walk and have an impact together on campus. We want to help each of these students.

Bob and I along with our LDR team are responsible for the staff, interns, and volunteers in our region. We make sure they are trained and equipped, are fully supported, have healthy staff teams, and are growing in their ability to lead others. Also, we are responsible for establishing new teams to go to more places so more students can know Jesus.

Each aspect of our role has a direct correlation to students hearing about Christ and growing in their faith.
