A highlight of the week was our "digital day of outreach." Students learned to share their personal stories of how Christ entered and changed their lives. They were given the opportunity to type or video record their stories. Many took the next step to post their testimony to their Facebook profile, email it to friends, or found other creative ways to use media and technology to spark spiritual conversations with others. The digital storytelling was a success, with over forty students recording their stories on video and over 1,000 views of the online student testimonies to date.



It was incredible to witness the ways God brought the Epicenter Experience together and worked in the lives of students present. At least six students accepted Christ during the conference one of those was Kyle from St. John Fisher College.



He said, "Throughout my youth, I've never truly been happy. Instead of solving the problem, I simply ran away from it and tried to claim that I was happy. My curiosity about the Lord started in September of 2011. My friends in FisherCru helped show me the way and answered my questions. I decided to attend the Epicenter conference two hours before the deadline because I prayed for the first time, and He answered. After the first session and going through the prayer journey, I talked with my roommates about my faith for hours. Then, at two in the morning, I finally surrendered to Jesus. Christianity made a lot more sense to me and I was finally persuaded that Jesus Christ died for my sins."

The final evening of the conference, Bret shared the story of Jonah and asked students to consider what "Nineveh" God might be calling them to bring His love and message. He then invited them to come and write their "Nineveh" on a giant wall at the side of the room. The wall was soon completely filled with students' covenants to follow God's leading.
