In January he went to Haiti, carrying the Gospel and bearing the image of Jesus to that impoverished and decimated land. He'll be taking a group of Cornell students with him to Haiti this summer.

Whether it is privileged Ivy League students on a prestigious campus, or hurting orphans destined

for a life of poverty, Edgar wants to bring the love of Jesus to them.

Now multiply Edgar by 41 and you see the impact you are making through your prayers and financial gifts. These young men and women look out at their world with the eyes of Jesus and see people harassed and helpless like sheep without a shepherd. Then they act, going where Jesus commands them to go. And you play a key role in helping them get there.

You are partners with us in this ministry. God has so constructed the body of Christ such that we need each other to fulfill the Great Commission, bringing the Gospel to the lost around the world.
