The Gospel is Bearing Fruit

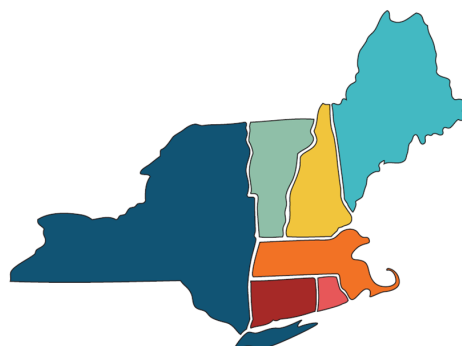
Some of the students who have come to know Christ this year:
