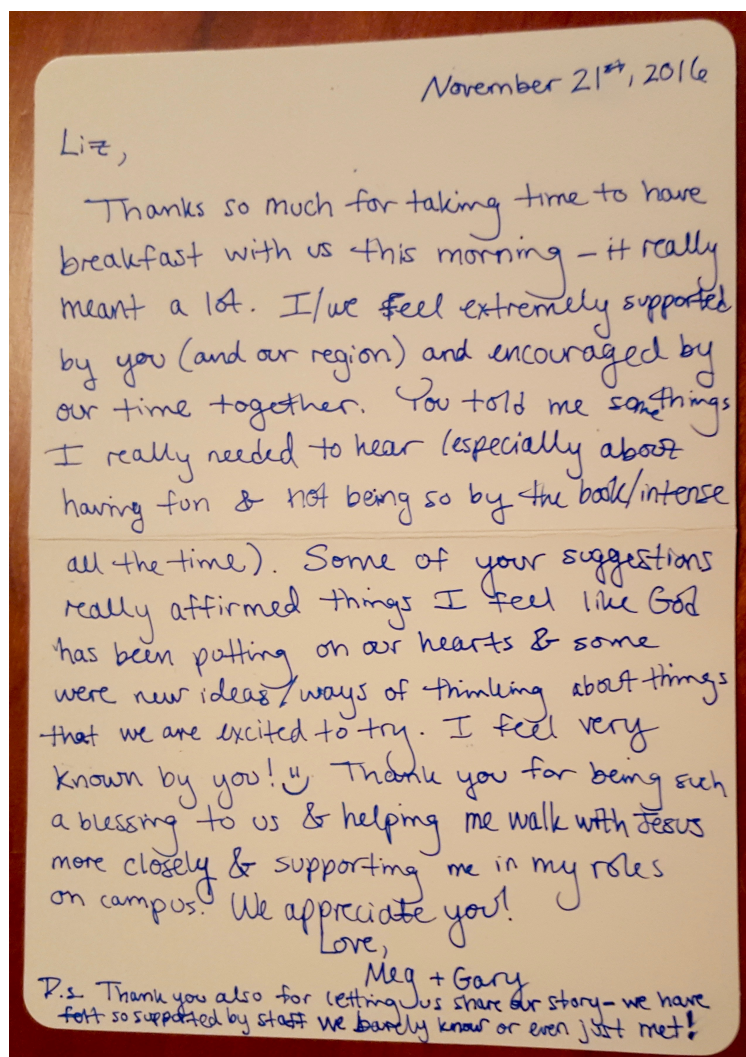
The Lord Leads
