During the 15 days we'll meet in small groups to study Colossians, have a pastor come to teach us some of God's attributes, pray together, and more. Please pray God speaks to us through His Word.

It is a great way to finish my year in France. Thank you for your faithful support and prayers. It is such a privilege to serve the Lord in fulltime ministry.
