



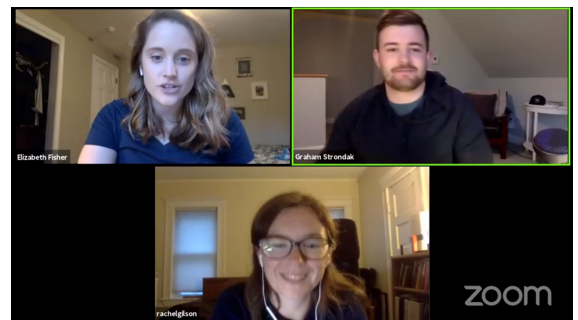

With everything going on, I thought you'd be encouraged to have some good news. First of all, let me say thank you. Your prayers and your financial support continue to have an impact as we move forward with the good news of God's love poured out in Jesus.

- The UMassDartmouth Cru group all gathered together digitally three weeks ago so that one of the leaders could share the story of her life and how Jesus lovingly intervened and changed everything.
- Our team in Providence coaches the student leaders at Manhattan College. They met weekly throughout the remainder of the semester, and actually added multiple new leaders to their planning and strategizing meetings in April.
- One of our staff, Maddie, has talked multiple times with a young girl she met in February who wants to reach her friends at Johnson & Wales.
- In the beginning of the semester at Bentley College, Andrew uncertain he was ready to multiply his faith, trusted God by accepting the call to discipleship with the intent to multiply. Then Covid-19 happened and he moved back home. He took a step of faith by sharing the gospel and the first discipleship lesson with his brother and sister.
