## HCJB Conferences and the "Summer Piggy Bank"

This summer HCJB Ecuador used our new office building and studios to host various conferences. At the end of May, 100 young adults came together for the Digital Missions conference.

The event featured speakers and conference leaders from different ministries in Latin America. They led the group in large group lectures, broke out into workshops, and finished the two-day event with a group project. The participants learned about using high quality video and photography, speaking skills, making a brand, and even using artificial intelligence for ministry online. We organized a WhatsApp group to share ideas before, during, and after the conference, and to continue learning from each other.

In June, HCJB held a conference on fundraising to help missionaries and ministries learn to raise funds in their communities, as more and more ministries no longer receive funds from other countries, like the USA. Several dozen Ecuadorian missionaries and ministry leaders took advantage of this time.

And, in August, we were able to have another conference with 30 of the participants in the Digital Missions group, to learn how to speak professionally on the air or on a podcast.

Also in August, because of a budget shortfall, HCJB launched the "Summer Piggy Bank", asking our audience to give a special gift and cover the \$60,000 shortfall in donations. We were able to raise \$52,000 toward that, and hope some more will come in.
