Washington DC was one of six cities that hosted a total of 4,057 students for Winter Conferences this year. We took 16 students from Buffalo to DC. Winter Conference is a special time that is focused on equipping students, wherever they are on their spiritual journey, to grow closer to Jesus. They are a place where every student is challenged to take their next step in making an impact for God's Kingdom. Students were trained how to share the good news of Christ at. Then were sent out to take steps of faith and initiate spiritual conversations in DC, and then back on campus this January.
