

## Easter Outreach



This Easter season Kevin headed up the first Cal Poly Good Friday Service. We reserved one of the biggest rooms on campus, put up 150 posters and stuffed 4000 plastic Easter eggs with candy and a flyer. The flyer announced the Good Friday service on one side and on the other it had the Easter story. Throughout the week, a student and often Kevin dressed up in an Easter bunny outfit to pass out all the eggs. On Good Friday, we had about 180 students come out to sing songs of gratitude to Christ and hear about how and why he died. There was not a dry eye while we showed clips from "The Passion of the Christ". One student who had never seen the Passion was so moved he had to step out of the service and he fainted and fell down several steps. Paramedics were called and during this time one of our staff, Joe, asked him why he thought this happened to him. The student said he didn't know that Jesus had to endure so much. Pray for Joe because he is going to follow up with this student and we believe he isn't a believer.

Also, throughout Easter week, on every student's favorite website Facebook.com (basically updated email), we put up 100,000 Easter banner ads. The ads get students thinking about Easter and if Jesus is who he says he is, then when they click on the ad it takes them to an article on a new website we launched called EverySloStudent.com. At the end of any of the articles there is a chance to learn more about Jesus or give your life to Christ. To date, 873 students have gone to the website and 18 students indicated that they prayed to receive Christ! We were blown away by the response, especially since this was a total experiment. We seem to have found a new way to reach students in a new culture...Praise God!

## Jenn's Spiritual Multiplication chain

Our goal with our disciples is to see them multiply their life spiritually...in other words, to pass on their faith and love for Jesus to others. Last year I started disciplining Arijaan. Part of discipleship is teaching them how to share their faith and what better way to teach but to go and do it. One day as I met Arijaan for discipleship, I told her that we were going to go talk to people about Jesus on campus. Her response was a flat out "no!" As we looked at Scripture, she prayed over the next week and reluctantly went with me and loved it.

This year Arijaan began to teach her bible study girls to share their faith. One sunny day on campus Arijaan took Kelley (a sophomore) out on campus to talk to students about Jesus. They sat down with Erin, a petite blonde freshman, to talk about what she believed in. They found out Erin had been recently attending a dorm bible study and that she was spiritually interested. So, they decided to share the gospel with Erin and at the end Erin said, "I guess I have never made this decision but I want to." Erin prayed to receive Christ right there in the busy student union! And if that wasn't amazing enough, the bible study that Erin had recently been attending was the freshmen bible study that I have been leading this year! I just finished up the 5 week follow up series with Erin to ground her in her faith.
