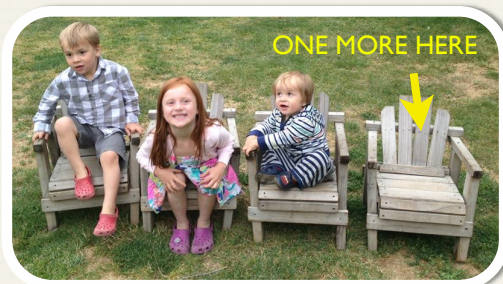
Changing the Image of CRU on Campus

We found out in January that we are expecting another little lamb, due early September!! We are all very excited to welcome one more little one. Abbey

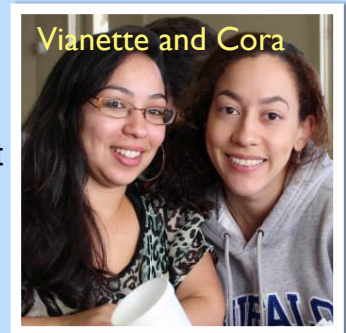


wants another little brother so she can be the only girl. And Dave thinks we need another sister in the family. Well at least one of them will be right. :)
