Our prayer team transformed our Crusade office into an intimate place, where they could get their heart right before the Lord, pray for revival on our campus, the Cal Poly students we have sent to the world, friends and family that need to know Christ, etc. Many of the prayer requests written were SO real: “free me from my eating disorder”, “help with cigarette addiction”, “lust”, etc. The great thing too is that the week of prayer was right before a week of outreach to the campus.
