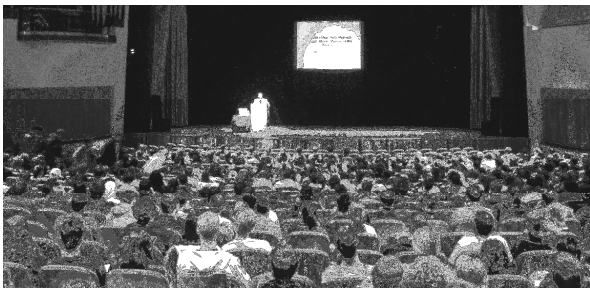

1500 Students Seek Truth on the College Campus

It was Monday at 6:30am. Kevin and 20 students gathered on campus in the dark cold morning to put up 300+ posters all over campus, and to hang 3 huge banners in the main part of campus. Throughout the rest of the week 7500 flyers were handed out. All of this was done in order to promote **The Veritas Forum** that was this past Feb 5 – 7th.

What is Veritas Forum? From the Latin words meaning "a public discussion of truth," The Veritas Forum is an opportunity for all Cal Poly SLO and Cuesta Community College to explore and discuss the hardest questions of the university. This entails society and the human heart in relation to the historical claims and contemporary relevance of Jesus Christ and the Christian faith. The Forum brought together qualified scholars from diverse fields to dialogue on crucial issues. We welcomed and honored skeptics and their questions.



What happened? Over 2 days we had 4 daytime seminars where we got 75 to 250 students to go to topics including "God Likes Sex", "Can the Bible Really be Trusted?", "Aren't Christianity and Science Enemies?", and "Creed and Credibility: What is the New Testament Saying, and Can It Be Believed?". Then Tuesday night

we reserved the biggest room on campus and 750 students came out to hear "Is Jesus Man, Myth, Madman, Messiah?" During each seminar the speaker would talk on the subject for 45 minutes then there was a 45 minute time where students could ask the speaker questions.

Results: In all we had about 1500 students come out to the different seminars. Tons of non-Christians came out to hear more about the truth of Christianity, and they asked lots of good questions. We have heard many stories about students that brought their friends who were considering and wondering about spiritual things and engaged in great conversations afterwards. Freshmen in the dorms have been gathering their non-Christian friends and listening to the recordings of these talks and then having a discussion afterward.

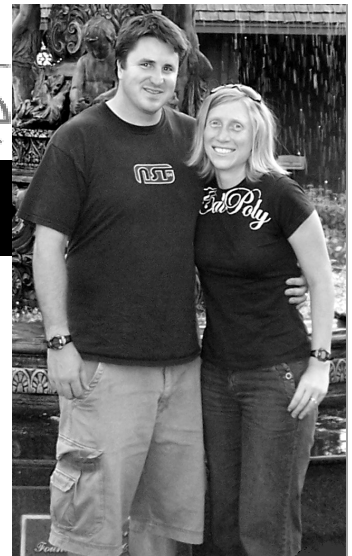

These couple of days gave answers to tough questions in the Christian faith. This helped our students become more confident in their walk with God as they love Him with all their mind.
