As you can see to the right our students took charge. **They lined the street that day with high energy cheering and welcoming the freshmen as they passed through their High Five tunnels.** We passed out 2,500 Freshman Survival Kits that contain a Bible, a water bottle, and other fun stuff. Students fill out a survey to get a kit and then we can determine their spiritual interest that our Bible study leaders follow up on. It was such a fun day!!
