“When I started college, I started developing feelings of loneliness, and even felt invisible at times. I tried to fill these voids with romantic relationships, partying with my friends, and finding my worth in my grades. None of this worked. I decided to join a CRU because I knew Christians were nice and thought they’d be good people to hang around. This is where I met Brooke, who used to be an intern with Cru. Brooke spoke to me with love and made me feel cared for during this time of transitioning into college. We started meeting weekly, where Brooke shared about who Jesus is and we walked through the book of John together.

Although, outside of this time, I still lived how I wanted to. Finally, my junior year of college, those feelings of loneliness, being misunderstood, and invisible intensified greatly, and this is when Jesus stepped in and captured my heart. Even though I have owned a Bible for as long as I can remember, this was the first time that I felt like I should open it and read it on my own. Jesus began teaching me how to read His Word and I felt like He was speaking directly to me. He revealed the sin I was living in, but also the redemption available through His death and resurrection. He began to change my desires to live a life that brings glory to His name. Through grace, by faith, I accepted Jesus Christ as my savior and began a personal relationship with Him. Seeking Jesus became a reality, and I no longer have those feelings of loneliness. I am so thankful to Cru and Brooke for taking the time to show me how that was all possible.
